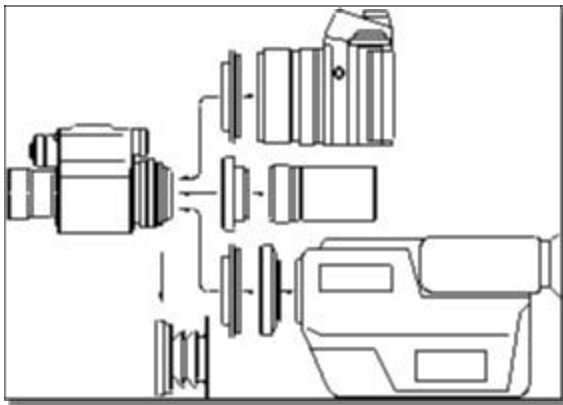

## Manual Insert for the Sibir Yukon Camera/Video Adapter

### Using with a Camera or Video Camcorder

Follow these steps to use your Sibir Night Vision product with a camera or video camcorder.

1. Turn the ocular ring all the way counter clockwise.
2. Remove the rubber eyecup from the Sibir Night Vision product
3. Attach the camera adapter onto the filter threads of your camera's lens. The camera/video adapter uses a 52/37mm thread size; a common filter thread size for many Nikon, Canon, Sony, Minolta and other lenses. Purchase a step-up/step-down ring from your local camera store if your lens does not use 52/37mm filters.
4. Thread the other end of the camera adapter into the eyepiece socket of the Sibir Night Vision product.
5. Make sure that you are in a dark area and that the lens cap is attached, switch the unit ON.
6. Focus the Sibir Night Vision product by turning the focus ring on the scope's ring. You may have to re-focus both lenses to achieve sharp focus.
